## Objectives

This 2020 study tour will undertake in conjunction with the Bahia Forest Dialogue Forum an analysis to understand historical progress on land use in the southern region of Bahia, the remaining challenges to be addressed, and the existing investment opportunities. Key issues include territorial governance, the organizational capacity of forest outgrowers, and developing relationships between plantation forestry and agriculture companies and local communities – indigenous, landless people and farmers.

We will connect experiences from Brazil with international perspectives to advance discussions and implementation on projects covering themes such as landscapes, land use, sustainable intensification, climate change adaptation and mitigation, and social impacts.

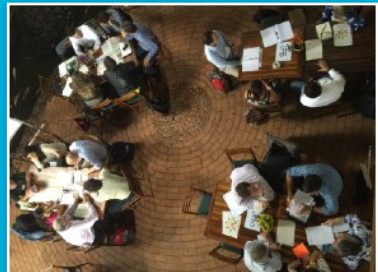
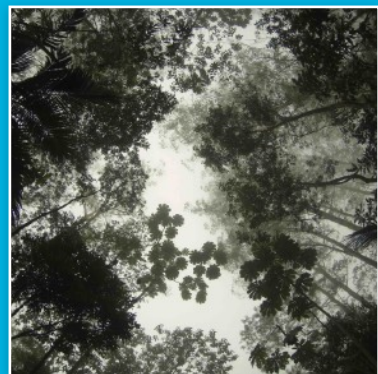
